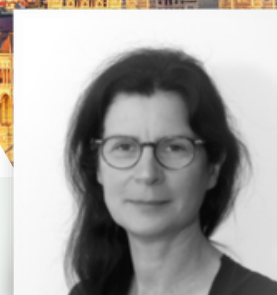

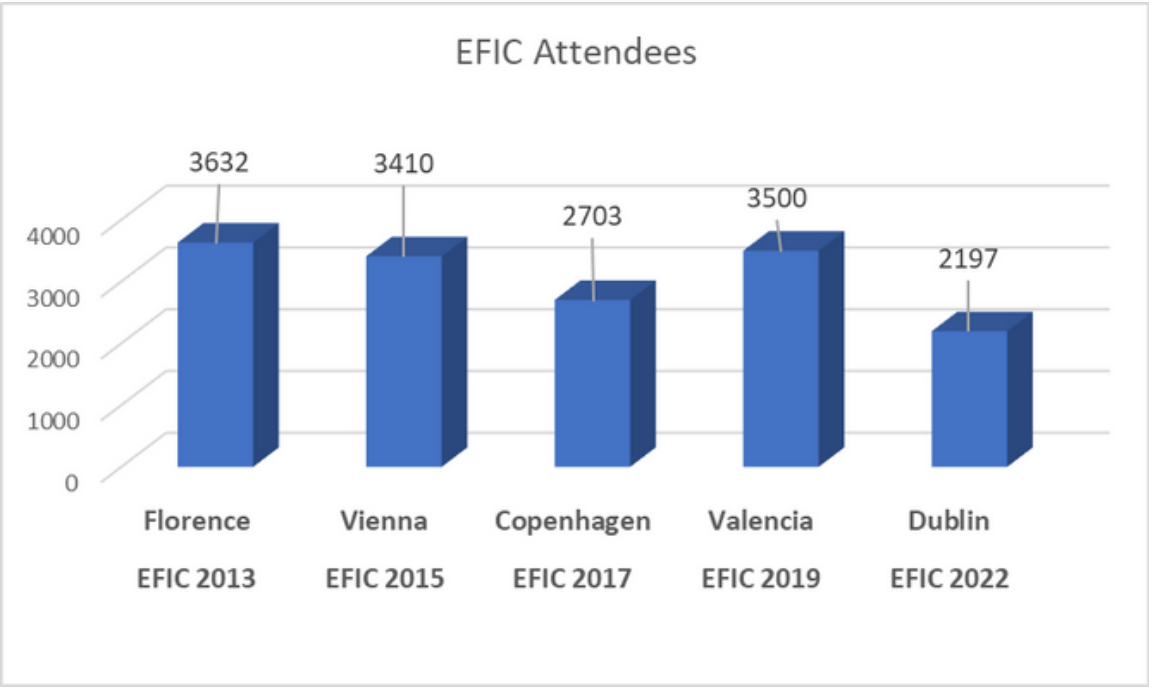


WHAT DO WE DO

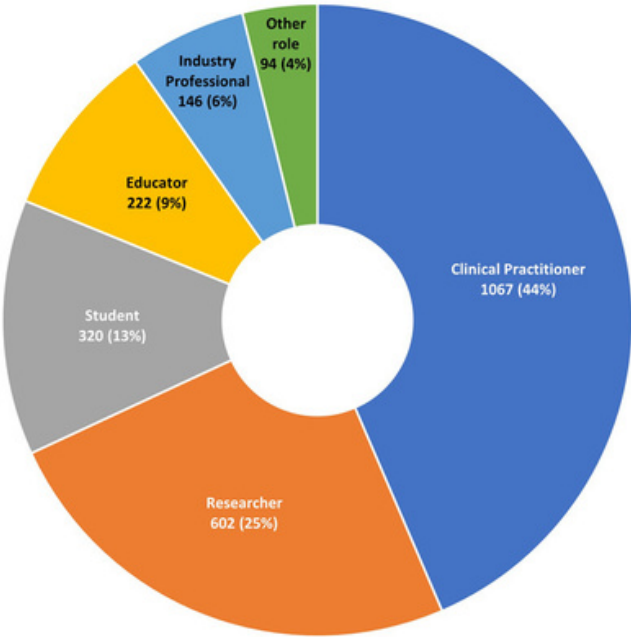
- Develop educational programmes to improve pain knowledge amongst healthcare practitioners

SESSION TYPES

HANDS ON WORKSHOP

An opportunity to jointly organise an educational workshop, up to 45 minutes long.

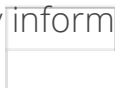
